Applicants are required to submit financial documentation that equals or exceeds one full year of expenses, for the program of study they are interested in pursuing. Adjustments in the financial certification cannot be adjusted based on a student's individual circumstances. This estimate is based upon 15 semester hours each semester for undergraduate studies, 9 semester hours each semester for graduate studies and full time enrollment for English language studies. A Certificate of Eligibility (I-20) or (DS-2019) will not be issued until this information is provided.

Scholarships available to international students at OSU are very limited and students' should not rely on scholarship funds to finance their educational costs. Refer to the International Guide for more information regarding scholarship opportunities available at OSU.

The amounts listed below are estimates that are determined by using the cost figures for 2012. The costs listed below are subject to change without notice. Historically, total costs have increased on an average of 5-10% each year.
